

Also the drawbacks and weakness of Muslim community.



It talks about the how it has affected the art literature and theatre badly. The era of mediocrity.



the entire real life of Balgandharva is like a novel. It is full of ups and downs, dramatic events and situations. He lived a long life (1888-1967). His tenure as a performing artist was equally elaborate. During his era, the socio-political situation was critically important. India had its struggle for freedom in the full swing. The industrialization was already a reality. It was affecting value system of the society. The theater had reached its



peak and then it was waning. Movie and a talky film had appeared. Women had acquired a new identity due to their education. Thus the change was in the air.

Balgandharva lead his life with both the extremities. He experienced the height of success, wealth, fame, popularity and he faced extreme frustration, failure, and poverty. He was received by the connoisseurs at the level of a deity. He was taken as a divine creation. I found it challenging as a writer. I started reading all the possible and available literature about him. It was more than four decades to his demise. In such case he had already become a living legend during his life time itself. His information was available in the form of literature, and books. He is survived till date through many anecdotes, memoires, opinions, controversies and gossips about him. There is no survivor who has witnessed and experienced his golden era at its peak. Add to that, we do not have a good tradition and taste for documentation. So I approached all possible sources and tried to re-create an image of Balgandharva. Thus, far it created the Balgandharva in the present novel. Through the monolith of history, authentic references, heresies and gossips and myths I carved and sculpted his character.


The mental and spiritual set up of Balgandharva and the state of his mind during the ups and downs in his life were the topic of constant contemplation for me. One has never seen Gandharva cursing his destiny, or blaming others for his suffering. He is never seen gaining sympathy for sowing something good and made to reap the bitter fruits for his efforts. He does not seem to be lost in the glory of his past. While he was enjoying all the blessings of his wealth and its benefits, he always had an inert observer in him. The feeling of detachment from all the worldly enjoyment might have rooted firmly in the psyche. Hence in the later part of his life he seems to look at his life as though he is experiencing some body else's life. I think that, if Balgandharva himself can be so detached about his life, we as a reader – writer should be so detached to keep the devotion aside.

This person having limitless talent, had some of the limitations as a human being. Those limitations should not be neglected. I have not neglected it accordingly, Even after coming to the terms with his limitations my respect towards him did not diminish a bit. Nevertheless, now for me he stands taller than I imagined him before.

They evolved a scientific cultivation pattern that turned farming into a gainful activity. Melghat today has set a benchmark for the schemes to fight malnutrition all over India. A total of 11 primary health centres (PHCs) have been opened in the area. They explored new and newer ways of transformation, but did not build an institution.





Synopsis

Around 1991-92, there was a disastrous eruption of AIDS in sub Saharan Africa. Millions of people had died, there was no place left to burry dead bodies, and no one to take care of the children orphaned as their parents died of AIDS.

Medicines for AIDS developed by the multinational pharma companies like Glaxo Welcome, Pfizer, Bayer, Hoffman La Roche became available by 1995. However, all these medicines were patented for next 20 years and hence the pharma companies had a monopoly.

The drugs were exorbitantly priced because of the monopoly and were priced at almost 20-30 times the annual income of a common poor African. Despite repeated requests by the African government, and the patient support groups, the pharma majors were not ready to slash down the prices of the life saving medicines. They didn't mind the poor people dying. What they were worried about were their profits.

Dr Yusuf Hamied, owner of the Indian pharma company Cipla, was ready with the generic version of the antiAIDS cocktail and he had offered to export it to Africa at a throw away price. However, he had to face tremendous pressure from the pharma majors. But finally they made the pharma industry shake in its boots and succeeded in supplying the drugs to the affected people.

ZachieAchmat, an AIDS activist and founder of Treatment Action Campaign fought for the rights of the AIDS patients in Africa.

Dr. James Love of Knowledge Ecology International was involved in negotiating with the UNAIDS program and Dr Hamied for supply of the generic medicines to Africa.

Dr. Peter Mugyenyi, a physician from Uganda, co-founded and became the medical director of the Joint Clinical Research Center, Africa's largest AIDS treatment and research center. In 2002, he ordered a shipment of low-cost generic ARVs from India in direct defiance of Uganda's patent laws, challenging the authorities to arrest him and refusing to leave the airport until the drugs were allowed into the country and guarantees were given that future shipments would also be cleared.

Because of these and many more unsung heroes, the antiretrovirals finally became available to the ailing Africans.

The book is a thrilling novel depicting the journey of the access to medicines campaign and people who contributed by their heart and soul in this movement.

India's patent policies in those days, allowed to produce the cheaper versions of the drugs like Cipla did as India truly believed that providing access to medicines to the poor is more important than creating monopolies. India amended its patent law in 2005 due to the TRIPS agreement coerced by WTO. However, India still remains the generic pharmacy of the entire world by providing cheaper generic medicines. Indian patent act still provides for such provisions and flexibilities, and this is one of the few things we Indians, should be proud about. The book also highlights India's role in providing cheap generic medicines to the world, rights from the access to medicines campaign since the African Aids crisis till today's exorbitantly priced Sovaldi by Gilead

The story of Intellectual Properties (originally 'Katha AkalechyaKaydyachi' in Marathi) is an attempt to educate lay persons on various aspects of Intellectual Property Law (IP Law).

IP Law is a subject that touches our lives in several ways every day. We come across several brand names which try to mimic the original brands. For example, we see bags with logos imprinted as "Abidas" in place of "Adidas". If we are buying such products, we are unaware that we are buying something which infringes a trademark which is a very important Intellectual Property. We blatantly forward articles deleting the author's name on social media, and we are ignorant that we are infringing an important Intellectual Property, copyright! When we eat a "KolhapuriMisal" in Pune, we do not even wonder how come a Pune vendor is selling a "KolhapuriMisal". And this happens because we are totally unaware about an Intellectual Property called Geographical Indicators. Whenever we do some important research and we feel it has a very good commercial value, we do not think twice before publishing a research paper. This happens because we are ignorant about a fact that by doing this, we are destroying the novelty of the patentable research and we may not be eligible to get a patent.

A common man is least bothered about knowing such things because he thinks Intellectual Property Law is a technical jargon and it is not his cup of tea! The reason for this is probably the fact that whatever has been written about this subject happens to be scholarly writing, which a common man finds difficult to comprehend.

In this book, an attempt has been made to avoid the technical jargon and the "language of law" and to write about all forms of Intellectual Property in a story telling way. Several cases have been discussed in a reader friendly way to make the subject more palatable. Right from the Basmati Story to Turmeric and Neem patents to formula of Coca cola to the ugly pictures on the cigarette packages to the copied Bollywood songs, several interesting stories have been touched upon. Also generic medicines, how the patents on the drugs make the medicines unaffordable and hamper their access has also been discussed at length.

The book is a compilation of several articles written as a part of the column "Katha AkalechyaKaydyachi" in the famous Marathi news paper "Loksatta". This was the most popular column in this news paper during that year and it was surprising to see the readers responding so much to such a technical subject. This underlined the importance of such technical topics being written about in a reader friendly way. Famous Marathi Publishing house "Rajhans Publication" decided to publish a book of the compiled articles by the same name. However, many articles were elaborated and many new chapters were written / rewritten for the purpose of the book. The book has won hearts of common readers and critics. It has received three awards so far, one of these three being the most prestigious CD Deshmukh award by the state government for Economics related writing given away as "
